**Matter Arising**

Planning Application for consideration:-

3PL/2018/0841/O Proposed Residential dwelling on land adjacent to 4 Drymere, Beachamwell

Cllr Sanderson asked for Councillors views.

Although the councillors are happy with the design they felt that the original objections to 3PL/2015/0189/F - 2015.03.17 still stood:-

1. Drymere is a forestry hamlet designed and built with specific objectives.
  2. Situated more than 3 miles from shops, Doctors etc.
  3. No main drainage.
  4. Would open floodgates for further development in Drymere.
  5. Increased traffic
  6. Adverse effect on wildlife
- He then read out three letters from Drymere residents, Mr Doug Saunders, Mrs Janet Blackbourn, Mr Darren Wakelen, Mr & Mrs Rod Pestell, who were unable to attend the meeting – all were strongly against the application.
  - He invited the public present to speak and three did – all were in favour of the application.

Cllr Sanderson then asked the Councillors to vote. 3 objected and 2 had no objection

The public present gave an indicative show of hands 7 no objection and 1 objection
